## THE TRIPLE TROPHY EXPERIENCE...

**LAKE TROUT.** Fat, aggressive fish smashing herring patterns right on the surface. Forget what you know about Lake Trout, and make way for a new favourite fish. Kasba's trout are found in shallow water all summer long and offer fantastic sport on the fly. They can be sight cast on shallow sand flats at the surface and at the shore edges in water up to about 10-ft deep. These beauties readily take any dry fly, but they prefer an attractor pattern they can see while slurping insects on the surface. These fish run between 2 to 5 lbs. pounds and swim just below the surface for easy targeting. Trophy monsters can run to 20 lbs to 30 lbs.

**NORTHERN PIKE.** Huge, hungry and accessible, Kasba's Northerns will give you a thrill you'll never forget. Spring finds Kasba's nasty Northerns content to bask in shallow sun-warmed bays -- until your bunny-strip comes along. You can use the same streamers used for lakers, but longer and tied with tougher materials. Big flies mean bigger fish, and Kasba has them.

**ARCTIC GRAYLING.** This is the classic dry fly fish, but if the day is windy or if it's midafternoon and no hatch is on, you can use nymphs. Old hands at Kasba recommend a bead-head nymph around size 14-16m. The hatch includes stoneflies, mayflies and caddis, and many anglers get great results with a fluffy size 14 fly. Here's a tip: Soak your flies at the bench with silicone, dry them and apply silica and paste floatant on the river to keep a single fly going for as many as two dozen fish weighing 3 or 4 lbs or more. This versatile, top-water feeding fish can also be taken with a variety of lures that are properly presented.
